

A bit of info about the venue:

Over Peover Village Hall is a little gem in the countryside. Just 10 minutes from the M6 and the bustling towns of Knutsford and Holmes Chapel it offers a bit of a break from the norm. There are no shops in the village but there are some lovely walks through Peover Park to stretch your legs at lunch in order to tune into those creative thoughts.

The Village Hall is a historical wooden building set in the grounds of a private house. It is a peaceful but spacious building with disabled access, kitchen facilities, was and parking on its doorstep.



Oh and it has some really interesting historical facts too – it was used as a convalescence building in both WW1 and WW2 for the recuperation of injured soldiers. It was one of a handful of huts that was built both at two of the large houses in the Village – Peover Hall a private home (www.peoverhall.com) and Colshaw Hall (www.colshawhall.com) now a wedding venue. This building was moved to its location from the grounds of Peover Hall which in WW2 was the HQ of General Patton. The village residents are currently busily raising money to keep this little historical gem in a good state or repair and part of the village for years to come.
